2e. COLONOGRAPH OR VIRTUAL COLONOSCOPY (VC)**Have you ever had a CT Colonograph or Virtual Colonoscopy (this is not a regular colonoscopy)?**

A CT Colonograph is a procedure done using x-rays with you lying on a table that is slid through a large circular scanner or a tunnel. Typically a tube is inserted to inflate the rectum with air. Preparation may include drinking fluid or taking laxatives to cleanse the bowel. You are not given medications to relax you or make you sleep. This procedure may also be referred to as a Virtual Colonoscopy (VC).
